InfoTrac Kids InfoBits

For: Elementary School students

Provides magazine articles and curriculum-related materials selected specifically for grades K - 5. Titles include *Boy's Life*, *Faces*, and *Jack & Jill*.

InfoTrac Junior Edition

For: Middle School students

Provides magazine articles and curriculum-related materials selected specifically for grades 6 - 8. Titles include *American History*, *National Geographic Kids*, *Science News* and *Sports Illustrated for Kids*.

InfoTrac Student Edition

For: High School students

Provides magazine articles, reference book articles, historical images, and maps for grades 9 - 12. Titles include *American Heritage*, *Technology Review*, *World Affairs* and *Popular Mechanics*.

Academic OneFile

For: High School students and up

A supplemental database that extends the coverage of *Expanded Academic ASAP*.

General Reference Center Gold

Goes beyond providing only articles from magazines & journals to include reference book articles from sources such as *Asimov's Chronology of Science & Discovery*, *Great Thinkers of the Western World* and *Masterpieces of World Literature*.

Hartford Courant - Historical

Search the earliest years of the *Hartford Courant* from the first issue published in October 1764 through 1922. Find articles and images that relate to Connecticut and national history.

A collection of Spanish / bilingual magazines and newspapers including *Siempre*, *Semana* and *La Opinion*. Search interface available in English and Spanish; presents titles in both Spanish and English.

Discovering Collection

For: Middle School and up

Need information about People, Places and Events? Search for essays, critical analyses, biographies, timelines, primary source documents, and multimedia files. Areas of study: geography (cultures and countries), literature, history, science and health.

Educator's Reference Complete

For: Teachers and School Administrators

Find articles about school law, child & adolescent psychology, human development, substance abuse, health/nutrition/ fitness, learning disabilities, and more.

Biography In Context

For: Middle School students and up

Biographies and images of newsmakers and figures of prominence from a wide range of fields. Covers ancient through contemporary times.

U.S. History In Context

For: High School students and up

For history buffs, class projects and assignments, this is the first place to look! Provides articles from magazines, journals, reference and non-fiction books; biographies, documents and speeches; maps and photos. Includes film and video clips of social, political and cultural events of the 20th Century to the present.

World History In Context

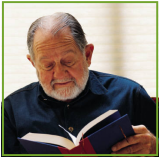
For: High School students and up

Extensive coverage of the 20th century, and also covers the Ancient Mediterranean, Ancient Near East and Asia as well as the Middle Ages, the Renaissance, the modern Middle East and Latin America. Moves chronologically from antiquity to the present and geographically around the globe, the events that define, inform and shape world history are covered with a sense of balance. This is an integrated collection of articles from journals, magazines and newspapers; reference works; primary sources; a graphical timeline, research guide, historical maps and images.

Science In Context

For: Middle School students and up

Focuses on key concepts taught in school classrooms including biology, chemistry, computer science, earth science, environmental science, math, medicine, physics, science-related biographies, space science, and more.



E-Reference Books, Library Catalogs and More

Virtual Reference Collection

Search the contents of more than 60 online reference books in arts, biography, health, history, law, literature, religion, science, health, history and social science online reference books.

Downloadable Audiobooks

Over 2100 digital audiobook titles from Ingram Digital Group targeted to schools but available to all. Titles can be downloaded to PCs or Macs using the free plugin called the Ingram Media Manager. From your computer, you can then transfer titles to iPods and certain MP3 players for limited times. Two checkouts and 3 holds are allowed at one time.

Adapted from What Do I Read Next? for better searching and with new Web 2.0 features. For everyone from students to professionals to casual readers.

Biography & Genealogy Master Index

For: Middle School students and up

A comprehensive index to biographical material on nearly 5 million people from all time periods, geographic locations and fields of endeavor. Provides names, birth/death years, and references to biographical materials.

Health & Wellness Resource Center

Find reliable consumer and alternative health information from journals, magazines and newspapers. Also has videos, a medical dictionary, encyclopedias and other reference titles.

Business & Company Resource Center

Provides current company and industry information and analysis as well as coverage of major business events and trends from 1983 to the present.

HeritageQuest

For: Genealogy researchers

Search U.S. federal censuses, family and local histories, and primary-source documents such as tax lists, city directories, and probate records. Materials date back to the 1700s. *Available through public libraries only.*

LegalTrac

Provides articles from over 100 publications reviewed by the American Association of Law Libraries, including the *Yale Law Journal*, the *Supreme Court Review* and the *Harvard Journal of Law and Policy*, and consolidates all of Thomson Gale's legal information into one database.
