## Magazines, Journals, Newspapers — *and more!*

### InfoTrac Kids InfoBits

For: Elementary School students

Provides magazine articles and curriculum-related materials selected specifically for grades K - 5. Titles include *Boy's Life*, *Ranger Rick*, *Faces*, and *Jack & Jill*.

### InfoTrac Junior Edition

For: Middle School students

Provides magazine articles and curriculum-related materials selected specifically for grades 6 - 8. Titles include *American History*, *National Geographic Kids*, *Science News* and *Sports Illustrated for Kids*.

### InfoTrac Student Edition

For: High School students

Provides magazine articles, reference book articles, historical images, and maps for grades 9 - 12. Titles include *American Heritage*, *Technology Review*, *World Affairs* and *Popular Mechanics*.

### Expanded Academic ASAP

For: High School students and up

Covers all academic areas including the social sciences, humanities, sciences, technology and current events. Sources include popular magazines and scholarly journals such as *African Arts*, *CLIO*, *Ethics*, *Film History*, and *Human Biology*.

### Academic OneFile

For: High School students and up

A supplemental database that extends the coverage of *Expanded Academic ASAP*.

### General OneFile

iCONN's largest collection of articles from magazines, newspapers, academic journals and trade publications. Titles include *Consumer Reports*, *Prevention*, *Forbes*, *Atlantic Monthly*, *National Geographic*, and *Popular Science*.

### General Reference Center Gold

Goes beyond providing only articles from magazines & journals to include reference book articles from sources such as *Asimov's Chronology of Science & Discovery*, *Great Thinkers of the Western World* and *Masterpieces of World Literature*.

### Hartford Courant - Historical

Search the earliest years of the Hartford Courant from the first issue published in October 1764 through 1922. Find articles and images that relate Connecticut and national history.

### ¡Informe! (Revistas en Español)

A collection of Spanish / bilingual magazines and newspapers including *Siempre*, *Semana* and *La Opinion*. Search interface available in English and Spanish; presents titles in both Spanish and English.

### Discovering Collection

For: Middle School and up

Need information about People, Places and Events? Search for essays, critical analyses, biographies, timelines, primary source documents, and multimedia files. Areas of study: geography (cultures and countries), literature, history, science and health.

### Educator's Reference Complete

For: Teachers and School Administrators

Find articles about school law, child & adolescent psychology, human development, substance abuse, health/nutrition/ fitness, learning disabilities, and more.

### AP Images

Search for contemporary and historical images from the Associated Press including photographs taken during the American Civil War, World War II, the Civil Rights Movement, and other major U.S. and world events from 1840 to present.

## Science Reference Center

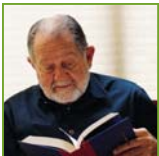
For: High School students and up

## WorldCat Library Catalog

Search for an item in thousands of library catalogs around the world, then locate it in a nearby library.

## Biography & Genealogy Master Index

For: Middle School students and up

A comprehensive index to biographical material on nearly 5 million people from all time periods, geographic locations and fields of endeavor. Provides names, birth/death years, and references to biographical materials.

## Health & Wellness Resource Center

Find reliable consumer and alternative health information from journals, magazines and newspapers. Also has videos, a medical dictionary, encyclopedias and other reference titles.

## Business & Company Resource Center

Provides current company and industry information and analysis as well as coverage of major business events and trends from 1983 to the present.

## HeritageQuest

For: Genealogy researchers

Search U.S. federal censuses, family and local histories, and primary-source documents such as tax lists, city directories, and probate records. Materials date back to the 1700s. *Available through public libraries only.*

## LegalTrac

Provides articles from over 100 publications reviewed by the American Association of Law Libraries, including the *Yale Law Journal*, the *Supreme Court Review* and the *Harvard Journal of Law and Policy*, and consolidates all of Thomson Gale's legal information into one database.

## reQuest Statewide Library Catalog

Main Catalog: Search all at once — 400+ Connecticut library catalogs; place interlibrary loan orders for materials owned by other libraries (if your home library offers this service through reQuest), and track their status.

Magazine Catalog: Search for publication titles to see what libraries subscribe to them. Link from the Magazine Catalog to articles in *InfoTrac OneFile*.
